Adult Education Bible Study – The Gospel of John and the Johannine Letters

This year we will be offering a 15-part study of the Gospel according to John and the Johannine letters, published by Little Rock Scripture Studies. Written in a poetic and symbolic style, John's Gospel and letters prayerfully reflect on Jesus and his eternal relationship to the Creator. This study invites you to meditate on God's overwhelming love. We will do the first 7 parts of the study in the fall, and finish the remaining 8 in the new year, before Lent begins. ***Rest assured — you do not need to be a scripture scholar to participate in this study!*** The materials we use are very thorough, and provide a great mix of educational and life-application content.
